The first game is Mandarin Chinese Speed Speaking! Similar to speed dating, we'll set up a row of tables and chairs. Novice speakers will be seated on one side and experienced speakers on the other. Once we begin, each pair will have 3 minutes to speak in Chinese about whatever subject they choose. (Ideas will be provided!) Audience members are welcome to listen in and cheer! After 3 minutes, the novices will shift to the next seat and another 3-minute session will begin. We'll run the game for 30 minutes.
